

Directions to Azé from Calais. This may not be the route the Sat Nav's take but we have found it to be the most direct and straightforward route with the minimum of tolls. It is about 430 miles and will take about 6-7 hours .

Take the A26 from Calais heading towards Reims. At Calais you will take your first toll ticket.

At Reims, you will pay your first toll and then you follow the signs for Lyon on the ring road around Reims – you stay on this and leave on the A26 heading for Troyes/Lyon. As you leave Reims you will pick up another toll ticket.

Stay on A26 to Troyes and then the road you need is the A5 heading towards Dijon/Lyon. The A26 leads into the A31 – proceed on this and then this becomes the A6 – keep following the signs for Lyon.

Once on the A6 you follow this road through to junction 27 – at Tournus – when you leave the A6. Be a little cautious as the slip road off to Tournus happens very quickly once you reach the brow of the hill. At Tournus you pay your second and last toll - follow the signs for Macon – bearing right once leaving the toll area.

You are now on the N6 – stay on this road until you get to the village of Fleurville. Go over the roundabout and then take the first right after the Esso garage - signposted D315 - towards Viré. Go past the Château on your left and proceed with caution – the next two junctions from your right have priority but you cannot see the first one very well - **go very careful!** (see sign below). As you leave Fleurville the D315 becomes the D15 – stay on this road all the way through to Azé. As you enter Azé, follow the road round to the left on the bend. On the right (after the turning for Cluny) is a high sided wall with trellis fencing up high – Les Portails Bleu is the house directly onto the road. You take the first turning on the right and park up in front of the large blue gates.



This sign indicates you are approaching a side road or crossroad and there is NO PRIORITY. In other words you must give way to any traffic approaching from your right. Sometimes you may not be able to see approaching traffic - so SLOW right down and approach with **caution**.

Directions from the south

Exit A6 at junction 29 – after toll area take first exit off the roundabout onto the N79.

Take first exit off N79 (junction 4) and head towards La Roche Vineuse on the D17. Go into the village of La Roche Vineuse and past the CA Bank and pharmacy and turn right onto the D85 towards Igé and Azé.

Keep on the D85 – through Verzé and Igé.

After leaving Igé you go through a small commune called La Martoret. Leave this and then stay on the road and as you drop down after the hill you enter Azé. At the T junction you turn left and enter the village and drive straight through.

Go past the CA Bank and Pharmacy on your left and you drive down a road lined with trees. As the trees finish and the road slightly narrows, there is a turning to the left (Montchanin) and our B&B is on this corner – you will probably notice the large blue gates in front of the courtyard.

Directions from Geneva

Head out of Geneva on the A40 heading towards Bourg en Bresse. Leave A40 at junction 1 (Macon) to get onto the N6 heading for Tournus. Stay on the N6 and you enter a village called Fleurville - turn left onto the D315 heading for Viré and Azé.

Go past the Château on your left and proceed with caution – the next two junctions from your right have priority but you cannot see the first one very well - **go very careful!** (see sign above). As you leave Fleurville the D315 becomes the D15 – stay on this road all the way through to Azé. As you enter Azé, follow the road round to the left on the bend. On the right (after the turning for Cluny) is a high sided wall with trellis fencing up high – Les Portails Bleu is the house directly onto the road. You take the first turning on the right and park up in front of the large blue gates.
